## Review

### Reflect

- 1. Have you (or someone you know) ever gone to the doctor for one thing but found out there was a deeper problem? What happened?
- 2. What we think we need. Read Mark 2:1-4.
  - What was Jesus doing when His real-life object lesson dropped in (verse 2)? Do you think it was a surprise to him?
  - The paralytic's friends did a "mission impossible" feat to get what they thought he needed. What are some "if only" things you have pursued and what did you learn?
- 3. What we really need. Read Mark 2:5 and Romans 6:23.
  - How does sin cripple us spiritually?
  - How does a person become "well" spiritually? How does the goldfish example apply to spiritual well-being?
- 4. Where we go to find both. Read Mark 2:6-12 and Mark 2:13-17.
  - What do Jesus' answers to the paralytic and the Pharisees show that He knows about the human heart?
  - What does the Pharisees' answer reveal about where they looked for spiritual healing? What are other wrong places people look today?

Read Isaiah 53:4-6 and consider Jesus' question – "which is easier?" How can you respond to the love and grace Jesus showed you at the cross? Is there an area where you have drifted from the real source of life and joy?
