Review

Main Points

Ask the group: What were your initial thoughts, reactions, and comments?

Reflect

- 1. **Road to Evil.** What do you think causes people to become evil or do evil things? How do they get from an innocent newborn to be able to lie, steal, and cheat?
- 2. Many little decisions. Read Mark 5:1-5 and James 1:14-15. How do you think this happened to the possessed man? Was it instantaneous or over a period of time? How do these passages help you understand how we all are able to slip down the road of evil? What has your experience been?
- 3. **Identity.** With most sin, what we value most becomes our identity. A very common lie we believe is that, "I deserve to more happy than I am." What we value you most, then becomes our identity? Have you ever had this experience? What was the result?
- 4. **Solution Read Matthew 5:6-20 and Micah 7:19.** What does our new identity and hope become in Jesus? How did this change in your life?

Read Mark 5:18-20. God sends the demon possessed man back to the town he grew up in. Where does God want you to go and who does he want you to interact with now that you have new life in Jesus?

- How can you make Jesus famous where God has placed you?
- Why do you think God has put you in the town, job, family, friend group you are currently in? How does he want to use you?
- Pray- Pray for God to give your opportunities to lead others to Christ.
