Review

Main Points

Reflect

1. **How we see ourselves. Read John 4:7-9 and v.16-18.** What informed this woman's view of herself, and how would you describe her overall view of herself? What are things that either others have said about you, or things that you have done that have informed your view of yourself? What's the loudest voice in your head?
2. **How God sees us. Read John 4:10-21.** What gift does Jesus offer the Samaritan woman, and why is it important that he told her he knew everything about her? How does God view her differently than how she views herself?
3. **Have you ever re-done a piece of furniture before? What was that process like?** How does that analogy help you see how God sees you?
4. **How we move from our way to God's way. Read John 4:25.** Why does the woman doubt what Jesus says about her? What makes us doubt the voice of Jesus? How does the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus help us to trust Jesus?

Respond

What happens when we do. Read John 4:28-29. What do you see in her response that you want to experience? How can you experience her freedom?
