3. **The Faith. Read Mark 5:25-26.** What must've that been like for the woman to go through 12 years with the same issues without any cure? What are the cures that you think or have tried in the past to fix your soul?
4. **Read Mark 5:27.** Why did that woman try Jesus? If someone were to ask you why they should try Jesus, what would you say? What would your report of Jesus be?
5. **The Power. Read Mark 5:30.** Why did Jesus perceive the power left him? What is the principle of substitution in your own words? See 2 Corinthians 5:21.
