Devotional Recap (Week 1)

Main Points:

1. The Hebrews Together journal is for a personal time of daily devotion through the whole book of Hebrews. Encourage your groups to pick their time and place each day to go through the devotional for the next 8 weeks.

Sermon Discussion (Hebrews 1:1-3)

Questions:

1. **Why prophets are great (Read Hebrews 1:1 / Exodus 3:2-10)**
 - What struck you the most about the example of passing a love note to a childhood sweetheart and how it relates to prophets? When was the last time you used a middle-man or middle-woman?
 - What was your biggest take-away about Moses as a middle-man?
2. **Why Jesus is greater (Read Hebrews 1:2-3)**
 - What are the 7 great characteristics of Jesus the writer mentions?
 - Why is it important that Jesus is not a middle-man, like the prophets?
 - How would you describe Jesus being greater than a prophet?
3. **Why that is great news (Read Hebrews 1:3b and John 17:3-5)**
 - What is the difference between the images we create of God and having a real relationship with the real Him- the "I Am?" Can you think of false images of God that are common?
 - Why is it so important Jesus sat down after making purification for our sins? What does that mean for you and for me?

Application

What's something that Jesus is saying to you to do, that you considering?

Prayer (Make this a weekly group priority)

Our goal during these 8 weeks is to make prayer an intentional and important part of our weekly time together. Leaders, try to aside at least 10-15 minutes a week. Here's a simple model for this week
