Main Points:

1. What did Jesus show you personally through his Word and the devotional this week? Did you encounter any situations or circumstances where you could apply truth from the book of Hebrews?

Sermon Discussion (Hebrews 1:3-14)

Questions:

1. **Why angels are great (Read Hebrews 1:3-7, 14; Psalm 148:2-5)**

 - Why were angels a big deal to the Hebrew audience? What are some characteristics of angels that make them great?
 - Why are angels a big deal in our culture and what are some misconceptions that cause people to be distracted?
 - Angels bring great news, but their messages are temporary and incomplete. Describe some examples of angels who left big, unanswered questions.
2. **Why Jesus is greater (Read Hebrews 1:8-13 and Matthew 17:1-5)**
 - What are some things that are great about Jesus in Hebrews 1:8-14?
 - Jesus showed his closest friends just a glimpse of his radiance in Matthew 17. What command did God give in verse 5 that we can also do in order to see his glory and experience his divine presence?
3. **Why that is great news (Read Hebrews 1:13-14 and Proverbs 22:17-19)**
 - How can Jesus, who sits at the right hand of God, be like a “hotel marker” to help you find your way daily?
 - What did God say in the Proverbs passage about the personal nature of God’s Word and its importance in our daily lives?

- *Angels are supernatural messengers created by God for a specific purpose (Psalm 148:5 & Hebrews 1:14).*

- *Scripture does not indicate that people turn into angels when they get to Heaven.*
- *Angels can take on the form of people (among other beings) but they are not actually people when they appear.*
