## Sermon Discussion (Hebrews 3:1-6)

#### Questions:

- 1. **Jesus is greater than anything and anyone.** What is swelling up in your life to be larger than it should? How do you tell and what impact does it have on you?
- 2. **Why Moses is great.** Come up with a list for all the reasons why Moses is great.
  - Read Matthew 17:1-8 and the Transfiguration. What stands out to you about Moses and Jesus here? Why was this time on the mountain even needed?
- 3. Why Jesus is greater. (Read Hebrews 3:1-2)
  - Go around your group. What's the first word or phrase that comes to mind when you consider Jesus?
  - Consider Jesus as your Apostle. Joe used the analogy of sending your child outside or going out yourself. How does that help you understand Jesus as Apostle?
  - Consider Jesus as your High Priest. Read Hebrews 1:3 and 2:17. How would you describe atonement in your own words? How does Jesus atone for our sins, and what does that mean for us? What complicates our understanding of atonement do you think?
- 4. Why that is great news. (Read Hebrews 3:3-6)
  - Talk through the illustration of Jesus building a house for you.
    What makes us long for a place to come home to and what words would you use for the place Jesus has for you

## **Application**

Hebrews is taking us on a journey, from weariness to rest, from alienation to the presence of God, and from isolation to community. Where do you fall on this spectrum right now?
