Review

Main Points: Initial Thought/Reactions/Comments

1. Jesus wants to come to your home.
2. Jesus wants you to see the people around you.
3. Jesus wants you to invite people into your home.

Reflect – Questions

1. **Read Luke 19:1-10.** Jesus could've spent time with Zacchaeus anywhere – but he went to his home. What does it mean to you that Jesus wants to come to your home? When you think about the difference between your public you and your private you, what comes to mind?
2. **Read Luke 7:36-50, especially v.44.** The question Jesus posed to the host, Simon, is thought-provoking. Do you see this woman? When we think of making Jesus famous, often times the last place we think is our home. A few questions: first, why is it hard at home? Second, who are the people in your home you want to make Jesus famous to? Third, what are ways you can do it this year?
3. **Read Mark 2:13-17.** We can learn a lot from Levi and his willingness to invite his friends to his house to make Jesus famous. Your house could be the only place some people will ever have the chance to hear about Jesus. Do you agree with that statement, why? How can you use your home with your friends to make Jesus famous?
