# Reflect – Questions

- 1. **On a scale of 1-10,** how would you rate your level of joy and why? What tends to fill your bucket and what causes leaks?
- 2. What he came to do. Read John 2:1-3. What are common reasons we think of why Jesus came, and how does this passage shape your answer? Share the last time you felt joy because of Jesus.
- 3. Who he is. Read John 2:6-11. If someone asked you to describe Jesus with a just a few words, what would you say? What does this passage tell us about Jesus, that may be different with how we usually think about him?
- 4. How he's going to do it. Read John 2:3-5. As you think about different ways Jesus describes our relationship to Him, what does the image of groom and bride stir up within you? What's the importance of the phrase "my hour has not come" in our understanding? If you struggle to see yourself in that way, why do you think that is?

## Respond

- 1. **Experience joy yourself.** If someone asked for your guidance, how would you tell them to find more joy in Jesus?
- 2. **Share this joy with others.** How does this passage encourage you or motivate you to share Jesus with others?

## Pray

Go around as a group and ask for prayer requests. Pray specifically for people to come to know Jesus in your life.
