 - The first problem: What makes it hard to ask for forgiveness? How do you tend to turn sideways, either with God or others?
 - The second problem: Why is hard to forgive? What sorts of tendencies do we naturally have instead?
- 4. **The price of forgiveness.** Read John 19:28-30 and 1 John 2:1-2 and talk about how Jesus pays for our sin. Why did he have to pay, and what does it mean that he is your advocate?

- 1. Who is someone you know you need to forgive or someone you need to ask for forgiveness?
- 2. How well do you receive the forgiveness of God for what you have done or undone?
