Reflect - Questions

- 1. AWE Read John 3:16-18 and 36
 - Describe how you felt when you realized the connection between how broken and messed up you were and how much Jesus loved you?
 - Why do you think people often lose their sense of awe for God's love?
 - How is obedience connected to love as you consider the two extremes of love and wrath (verse 36)?

2. FEAR

- Consider the story of Togo and the dog-sled rescue in Alaska. Can you think of any stories from your life, movies or books that illustrate a hero rescuing people in danger of perishing?
- How do you see love and wrath connected?

3. WONDER

- What gets in the way of people seeing themselves as loved by God?
- How did Joe's example of the engagement ring help?

Pastor Joe challenged us as a church to keep our focus on what is most important- that CCC is a rescue mission. How might our group help one another and our church maintain that focus? Who do you know that is perishing and needs Jesus?
