The 10 Commandments – Don't Make Me Up

Check In

Pick a question to see how the people in your group are doing with Jesus. See the template for ideas!

Story

Have one person or one couple share their story, if you are doing this idea.

Discussion

- Read Exodus 20:4-6.
- **The Negative:** Do not make an image of me. What's an image of God you had in the past or still tend to have in the present? Why are we tempted to make an image of God?
- **Why It Won't Work:** Reread v.5-6. What is bound to happen we make an image of God? How have you seen that play in your family or friends?
- **Connect Jesus to the command:** Read Colossians 1:15-20. Jesus is God in flesh. How does this passage give us a real picture of God and remove any images? Come up with as many words describing the real Jesus.
- **The Flipside:** Because Jesus is real, and not an image, we can have genuine relationship with God. In this relationship, we can expect Jesus to surprise and disagree with us? How do you see that in your relationship with him? Also, we can trust Jesus to actually love us. Why is that good news for you?
- Apply the command personally.
 - What does it look like for you to practically obey this command this week? What image of God do you need to be shattered or changed?
