# Discussion

Read Exodus 20:15

## Why is it wrong to steal?

- Do you have any stories like Joe's daughter, Becca, where you felt violated when someone took something from you?
- God wired us to have and care for things. Why do stealing and hoarding cause a disconnection with God and others?

#### How do we steal?

- Joe said "blue-collar" taking (literally taking things) is quantifiable while "white-collar" taking (hiding professional short-cuts) is more subtle. How have you seen these play out in your life or those around you?
- Read Malachi 3:7-12 in full. What sticks out to you about God's view of poor stewardship and his blessing for generous stewardship? In what ways does this hit home for you?

#### How do we become generous people?

- Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 8:7-15. How does this passage about God's generous love for you encourage you during this time of crisis?
- Have you had the opportunity to experience or express generosity this week?
- What do you have right now that you can be ready to be generous with this week?
