Questions:

- 1. **Read Matthew 1:20-23.** Mary and Joseph's view of God changed, as they realized God wanted a relationship with them. When in your life have you realized the difference of knowing about God and actually knowing God? What does Jesus being Immanuel mean to you?
- 2. The second change is in how they view themselves. When was a time when someone impacted your self-image without even trying? How does Jesus do that with us?
- 3. As Christians, should we have a positive or negative view of ourselves, why? What's your general view of yourself?
- 4. **Read Matthew 1:21.** How does this change the view of salvation for Mary and Joseph? Joe made the point that our primary need is inside of us and not outside of us. What makes it hard or easy to believe that?

Respond

What's the application God is moving you towards? As God has drawn near to us – what does it look like for you to draw near to someone in need? Maybe it's Just Because cards. Maybe it's some other way.
