### Reflect

Read Luke 10:16-20.

#### Questions:

- 1. **Read Luke 10:1-3.** Jesus sends out 72 disciples to go out and tell others about Jesus. The pattern throughout the Bible is those who have been saved are sent, those called are sent out, and those blessed, called to be a blessing. Is that a normal way you think about yourself, why or why not?
- 2. Joe references that we are asked to give what we have already been given as a way to serve and make Jesus known. What are some resources or skills God has given to you that you can use to serve him and others? What gifts are you a handler of, like Joe's grandchildren at Christmastime? Have people share about each other that gifts they recognize in each other.
- 3. **Read Luke 10:17-18.** What is a name you've dropped before and why? What do these verses teach us about the power of Jesus and his name? How does this impact us as followers of Jesus and how should this impact our serving?
- 4. **Read Luke 10:20.** What's the struggle in this passage? Why do you think Jesus says this in verse 20? How do we protect ourselves from this?

# Respond

The question in this passage is straight-forward: where is God sending you, and who does he want you to serve? Maybe it's a family member. Maybe it's with a stranger with Just Because. Or maybe it's a mission trip next year. Go around the circle and share how God is moving in you to respond? What are the things that stand in your way?
